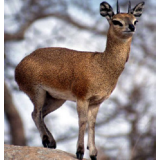


## THINGS TO SEE



### KLIPSTPRINGER

*Oreotragus oreotragus*

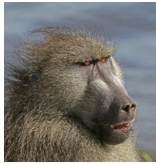
A small, sturdy antelope; it reaches 43–60 centimetres (17–24 in) at the shoulder and weighs from 8 to 18 kilograms (18 to 40 lb).



### ROCK HYRAX (DASSIE)

*Procavia capensis*

It is a medium-sized terrestrial mammal between 4 kilograms (9 lb) and 5 kilograms (11 lb) in mass, with short ears and tail.



### CHACMA BABOONS

*Papio ursinus*

On our side of the bay the baboons are still wild and prefer to stay away from humans. Please do the same, and DO NOT FEED THEM.



### WHITE PINCUSSION PROTEA

*Leucospermum bolusii*

A white protea species only found in the mountain above Gordons Bay. The flower heads are about 2 cm in diameter, with pin like petals.

## HIKE SAFELY

Even though this path is conveniently close to the town, it is still a wilderness trail. Please make sure that you wear the appropriate gear: Sturdy shoes (no flip flops), a hat or cap, sun screen. Bring a jacket, even on hot days, as the wind can blow quite harsh and cool you down significantly. Have enough food and water (1 Liter per person) on you, and never hike alone, best is a group of 4 people. If you need help in a wilderness environment please call 021-937 0300 and state clearly who and where you are and what happened.

## TRAIL HISTORY



I built the trail in the late 1980s with the help of my two daughters, Chanel and Lisa. I was Mayor of Gordon's Bay at the time and decided to call it "the Mayor's walk". In later years the Gordon's Bay municipality decided to rename it to "Danie Miller Trail".

The trail is about 2.9km long, starts at Aurora Drive and ends near the

end of Suikerbossie drive. It is a contour walk for young and old and follows the contour above the top houses along the length of Gordon's Bay just below the anchor and will take about 2 hours to walk. It has spectacular views of Gordon's Bay, False Bay and the harbour.

The trail has recently been incorporated in the Kogelberg Biosphere and will be controlled and maintained by the Biodiversity Management of the City of Cape Town.
